The GSSHS Good Standing Plan relates directly to the student Code of Conduct, which in turn is derived from our School Values of:

The Good Standing Plan provides a framework to promote and maintain high standards across all of the dimensions of student behaviour, focusing on the following target areas:

- Commitment to academic success
- Conduct

All students commence their school year with Good Standing. Students maintain their Good Standing by meeting the school's expectations in terms of the target areas above.

Students can achieve 'Advanced Standing' by consistently meeting the school's expectations and striving for excellence, and by making valuable extra contributions to the school community. This can include representing the school in sporting teams, music ensembles and other artistic endeavours, debating, volunteering, or playing a leadership role.

Individual student Good Standing status will be monitored continuously and regularly communicated to students. Students who lose Good Standing will be given every opportunity and support to return to Good Standing within the given time frame.

Performance against the criteria in the table below determines a student's Good Standing status.

- Parent/guardian notification on award of Advanced Standing

#### Students will be supported to re-gain Good Standing in the following ways:

- Case managed by Year Coordinators
- Explicit targets set for return to Good Standing dependant on initial cause:
  - Minimal negative behaviour reports
  - Improvement in work ethic
- Reviewed every 2 weeks
- Written notification to parents

Students on Conditional Standing are not permitted to attend excursions or school events judged to be extra-curricular, including any reward activities.

## Students on Loss of Good Standing will be supported to re-gain Good Standing in the following ways:

- Formal Good Standing Contract entered into with Student Services program coordinators or Vice Principal including explicit targets for return to Good Standing
- Daily monitoring (tracking sheets) to keep on track for improvement

Students who lose Standing are not permitted to attend excursions or school events judged to be extra-curricular, including any reward activities.
