2024 CONTRIBUTION & CHARGES COSTS

All students of Governor Stirling Senior High School will receive a quality education based on the WA Curriculum.

The School Curriculum and Standards Authority (SCSA: https://www.scsa.wa.edu.au) provide additional information about assessment and certification of subjects offered to your child at Governor Stirling Senior High School.

However, we also offer opportunities for your child to enhance their learning journey by offering an array of Specialist programs. There are additional charges for these subjects due to the higher cost of providing these options.

All information for school costs are provided to parents/caregivers two months prior to the school year.

The amount you are required to pay will be based on the subjects your child selects. Your child's selections will not exceed these amounts.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS & VOLUNTARY APPROVED REQUESTS

We believe that the best way to provide quality education is through the provision of modern resources and equipment for students. Your payment of the *VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS* will result in improved educational resources, options and support for your child's learning experiences. Governor Stirling Senior High School urges you to pay this portion to enable Governor Stirling Senior High School to provide your child with the education that fits their interests and abilities.

CHARGES

Specialist Programs

If you accept a place in our Specialist programs, you will be accepting this *CHARGE* and should pay 50% immediately and pay the balance in Term 1.

Senior Schooling

Year 11 and 12 subjects all have a *CHARGE* attached as per Department of Education policies. All *CHARGES* are compulsory and must be paid in full.

Years 7 to 10

In addition to a curriculum-based education program, we offer your child a selection of optional subjects to enrich and explore their educational opportunities.

These have an additional *CHARGE* due to the higher cost of providing these options.

Other Optional Charges

These are for voluntary courses and activities where your child elects to participate. These are voluntary but the charge is payable if the student opts to participate. Eg. excursions.
